

MINICOM CALLS

(Without direct line)

A QUICK GUIDE.....

HOW TO TELL IF IT IS A MINICOM CALLER

When you answer the phone you will hear:

- an electronic voice announcer saying “hearing impaired caller, please use tdd” or
- an electronic ‘beeping’ noise much like a fax bleep or
- silence

WHAT TO DO NEXT

- Switch on Minicom
- Put the telephone handset on the minicom with the lead to the left.
- Using the keys on minicom to type in..”**HELLO THIS IS ??? ...GA**”
- If nothing happens type in..”**HELLO GA**”
- You will then see your callers typing appear on the screen. It will be your turn to type again when you see GA
- When you have finished your conversation type in “**BIBI SKSK**”
- When you see that the other person has typed in “**BIBI SKSK**” You can now put the telephone handset back on the telephone and switch off the minicom

NOTE: **GA means Go Ahead - your turn to type**
 BIBI means Bye Bye
 SKSK means Stop Keying
